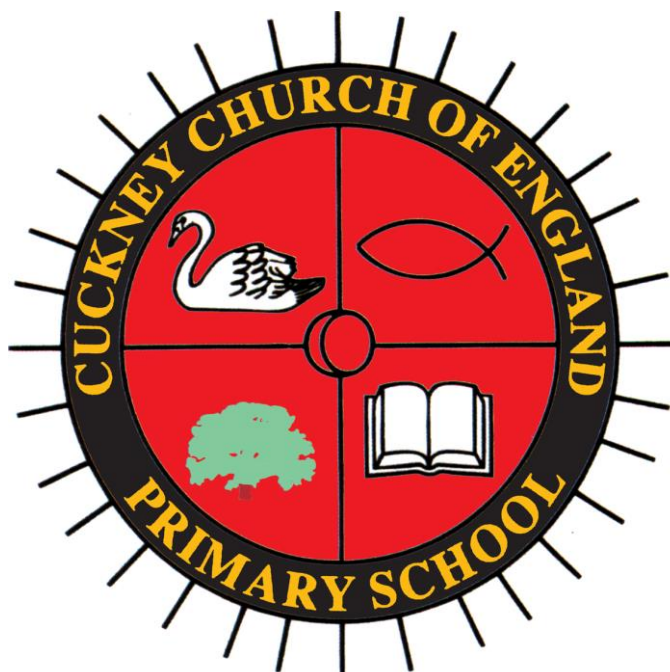

Home/School Agreement can be found in the front of the school diary, which are given to pupils at the beginning of the school year. This agreement should be read and discussed and involve teachers, pupils and parents. All three parties should then sign the relevant section. The agreement is as follows -

The School will:

- Value and respect each child as an individual
- Provide a safe environment for learning
- Assess the child's needs and plan for progress in all areas of developments
- Recognise and praise progress and achievements
- Inform parents of the progress and welfare of their child
- Communicate targets and achievements to pupils and parents
- Listen and respond to parents' views and concerns
- Provide and monitor homework which is appropriate to the child's needs
- Encourage the children to wear school uniform with pride

The Parents/Carers will:

- Support the school in its aims and values
- Ensure the child's regular and punctual attendance
- Notify the school of the reason for absence before 10am on the first day of absence wherever possible to help detect absence unknown to parents
- Support the school's policies on Behaviour and Homework
- Tell the school about any circumstances which may affect the child's behaviour or ability to learn
- Attend Parents' Consultation Evenings and discussions about their child's progress whenever possible
- Ensure their child wears appropriate clothing and footwear for the various activities in the classroom, the playground and sports areas, including the use of school uniform for normal attendance
- Recognise the value of the work done by the PTFA – The Friends of Cuckney School and support this whenever possible
- Adhere to the school's Traffic and Parking Policy to help to ensure safety immediately outside the school

- Attend school regularly and punctually and bring correct equipment
