Dear Parents

Having today reviewed our Outbreak Management Plan for the COVID-19 outbreak in line with guidance from the Government and Public health, I am writing to update you on the current situation at school.

Due to the success of the restrictions put in place during this outbreak, as part of the Outbreak Management Plan, 2 classes stayed Covid free and 2 classes have not had any further cases of COVID-19. One class has had further cases, but not for a week.

This is really good news and we want to thank you for your support in helping us to manage this outbreak.

We now feel that we are able to start to lift some of the restrictions put in place.

1. From tomorrow Tuesday 14th December, Holbeck, Sherwood, Langwith and Thoresby classes will not need to 'bubble'.
2. Welbeck class will stay in the hall and will continue to 'bubble' until Thursday, when they will start to move their things back to Welbeck classroom.
3. Breakfast club for children in Holbeck, Sherwood, Langwith and Thoresby classes will resume from **tomorrow morning, Tuesday 14th December 2021**, so if you wish to book a space please do so. Breakfast Club will take place in Welbeck Classroom until the end of term, so please drop your child at the top red door in the mornings.
4. Welbeck class children will be able to attend Breakfast Club from **Thursday, 16th December 2021**, when they will be out of their 'bubble'.
5. We will continue with drop-off and collection on the field until the end of term as one class are still bubbling until Thursday and in order to maintain social distancing.
6. Due to the hall still being out of action until Thursday, all Christmas parties will take place in the classrooms and all teachers have the food, games and activities sorted to do this. Clubs will resume after the holidays.

At this time, we would like to remind everyone that COVID-19 has not gone away and therefore please continue to be vigilant and to maintain sensible precautions and hygiene routines.

Please can we remind you that if your child is not feeling well, please do not send them to school.
