RE: Arrangements for September 2021

Dear Parent / Carers,

Given recent DfE updated publications, I write to inform you of arrangements for September. All plans assume there will be no further changes by the government over the summer.

Mrs Moss will continue as 'catch up' teacher and will work with Langwith and Thoresby classes.

From this you may have gathered that Miss Kennerley and Mrs Walls will be moving on. It is with a heavy heart that we have to say goodbye and we wish them both the best of luck in the next chapter of their careers. We would like to thank them for the commitment and dedication they have shown to the school.

Organisation for September (assuming no changes over summer) –

- School will have prepared an Outbreak Management Plan, in order to be well prepared to step up (or down) restrictions if/when required to respond to localised outbreaks.
- There will be no staggered start and finish to the day. School times will revert back to a 8.45am start and a 3.15pm finish.
- Classes will no longer run in bubbles and children will be able to mix freely during lunchtime and playtimes. School may temporarily reintroduce 'bubbles' according to the outbreak management plan if required.
- Assemblies will resume.

- From 16<sup>th</sup> August children will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are a close proximity contact. Track & trace will be the responsibility of the NHS and no longer the responsibility of the school. NHS will contact individuals if you are required to take a PCR test.
- Face coverings will not be required, however the government are advising these are still worn as a precautionary measure in densely populated areas, such as on school transport.
- We will welcome parents back on to the school playground to collect and drop off children, but advise you remain at an 'appropriate distance' where possible. You must arrange an appointment with a member of staff in advance to enter the school buildings. Please do not 'pop in' to hang up a bag on a coat peg for your child. This will support the outbreak management plan.
- Staff or pupils who take a positive LFT will be required to self-isolate, school can refuse to admit a pupil if necessary to protect the other pupils and staff from possible infection.

Control measures will remain in place and we will –

1. Ensure provision is in place to maintain good and hand respiratory hygiene.
2. Maintain appropriate cleaning regimes.
3. Keep occupied spaces well ventilated.
4. Follow public health advice on testing, self-isolation and managing confirmed cases of Covid19.
