RE: Remote learning and Key worker provision

Dear Parents/carers,

I write with some updated information regarding the arrangements for this week.

Remote learning –

If your child is remaining at home this week we have arranged work for your child to complete. Different classes have made provision in different ways, some have emailed all work out and others plan a full week online on Google classroom. It is expected that your child will be learning for three hours a day, made up of an hour literacy, an hour numeracy and an hour of another curriculum area. The guidance states this is a minimum. If your child is working online, then all the teaching is provided by the class teacher. If work has been emailed then your child may need some support to complete tasks but direction should still have been provided by the class teacher, to support parents at home. Teachers and Teaching Assistants will be in contact with you to ensure you have everything you need to enable children to learn, either online or in hard copy. Please do not hesitate to ask if you have questions or need support with something. We are here to help and welcome your feedback.

Key worker provision –

The school day for key worker pupils will revert back to the normal school day. Pupils should arrive at 8.45am and collection is at 3.15pm. Pupils should wear school uniform and bring appropriate footwear and outdoor coats for playtimes. Please bring a water bottle, which should return home daily for cleaning. Please do not bring any other equipment, school will continue to provide all other resources. We also recommend additional base layers as windows will remain open to maintain good ventilation. Children are welcome to request a hot meal from the school kitchen or bring sandwiches if they prefer. Please book and pay for all school meals in advance on scopay.

Consistency –


Home learning and the learning of key workers will be ***exactly*** the same. It will be planned for and provided by the class teacher. With this in mind, we have agreed a universal format for sessions and breaks so online learning can be delivered to pupils at the same time, regardless of whether they are at home or at school.

These sessions are –

Session 1	9am-10am
Break	10.15am – 10.30am
Session 2	10.45am – 11.45am
Lunch	12pm - 1pm
Session 3	1.15pm – 2.15pm
Break / session 4 independent task	2.15pm onwards
