Dear Parents / Carers,


I thought it timely to write regarding the return of pupils to school tomorrow. We understand that given the announcement made by Boris Johnson on Saturday some of you may have concerns about sending your child to school. None of us know exactly what the future holds for schools over the coming weeks, but I will be in touch if we are informed of any further changes. However, **currently school remains open to all children.**

We are thrilled to be welcoming our families back to school after the half term break and staff have prepared lots of exciting learning opportunities for children to engage with. We have, of course, reviewed the school risk assessment and are fully confident that we have made the school as safe as possible for children to attend. I would like to inform you of the following updates –

- Miss Worboys is self-isolating for the remainder of this week and so will not be in school. The class will be covered by the very capable Mrs Morton and Mrs Moss. Miss Worboys has provided all of the planning and learning activities to be delivered this week to provide continuity for our children. We expect her to return to school next Monday 9th November.
- We advise all adults to wear appropriate face coverings during drop off and collection. This is not a mandatory requirement, but we know our parents and carers are responsible and will want to protect all community members. Many Thanks for your support with this.
- Please ensure all families, adults and children, social distance on the field at all times. **Mixing of households is not allowed indoors or outdoors.** We ask that once children have been collected that you leave site immediately. Please do not allow children to play on the play equipment; this is another area where transmission could easily take place and one which is not the responsibility of school to clean or maintain.
- Once again, Mrs Fletcher has thoroughly deep cleaned the school site over the half term break in readiness for pupils returning and has done a fabulous job. Thank you to Mrs Fletcher for all her hard work. Cleaning routines continue to an increased level.

Finally, please contact your child's class teacher in the first instance with any concerns you may have. If you find they are not able to answer you are welcome to contact Mrs Plumb in the school office of myself via telephone or email.
