Key Stage 1 Parents – Holbeck and Sherwood

Parents of children in Holbeck and Sherwood classes will need to sign in at the school office on arrival. After signing in, please collect your child directly from their classroom and bring them to the hall where the Mother's Day activity will be taking place.

Please note that from the moment you sign in and collect your child, responsibility for your child transfers to you for the duration of the session.

Once you have completed the activity together, you are welcome to:

- Sign out and take your child home,
- Bring your child back to their classroom and sign back in, or
- Visit and join older siblings in their Key Stage 2 classrooms.

If you choose to leave the school site with your child, please ensure you sign out at the office before departing.

Key Stage 2 Parents – Langwith & Welbeck

Parents of children in Langwith and Welbeck will also be asked to sign in at the office on arrival. You will then join your child(ren) in their classrooms where the Mother's Day activities will be taking place.

At the end of the session, you have the opportunity to take your child home. However, you must ensure that both you and your child are signed out at the office before leaving the school site.

Please note that any children who do not have a parent or carer attending the session will still be very much included in the Mother's Day activities and will enjoy a fun-filled afternoon of crafts and celebrations together.
