

Young Voice 2026- Final reminders and information

Dear Parents,

Just two more sleeps until our concert day (Thursday 12th February) and our final preparations are almost complete- how exciting! In this letter, you will find a checklist of things you need to remember for the day. If you have not done so already, please **email Miss Worboys (email below) stating any medication children will need to take** i.e. travel sickness tablets or inhalers. We will take all allergy information and contact details directly from Arbor so please ensure these are up to date and correct.

Checklist for choir children	✓
Arrive at school for the usual time of 8:45am 'concert ready', wearing Young Voices t-shirt (we recommend a jumper on top to keep it clean), black bottoms and comfortable shoes such as trainers. Torch lights are at school and will be given out at the arena to minimise chances of losing them. <i>Children may wear a SMALL amount of face and/or hair glitter (festival style) but this must be applied before school and children are not permitted to take this with them. Children can also wear nail varnish should they wish. No other makeup please.</i>	
A suitable and substantial break time snack to eat before we depart (10:40am) as we will not be having lunch until we arrive at the arena approximately 1pm.	
A packed lunch to take with them to the arena. Clearly identified so not to be confused with their packed tea. (flasks are allowed).	
A packed tea to take with them to the arena. <i>Children can also bring snacks including some sweets- not too many please!</i>	
Water bottle/ drinks (not fizzy) for the afternoon and evening. Please send plenty! <i>(There is a water station to fill up bottles if needed).</i>	
Collect children from school at approximately 11:15pm (a text message will be sent to give a more accurate ETA on the night).	

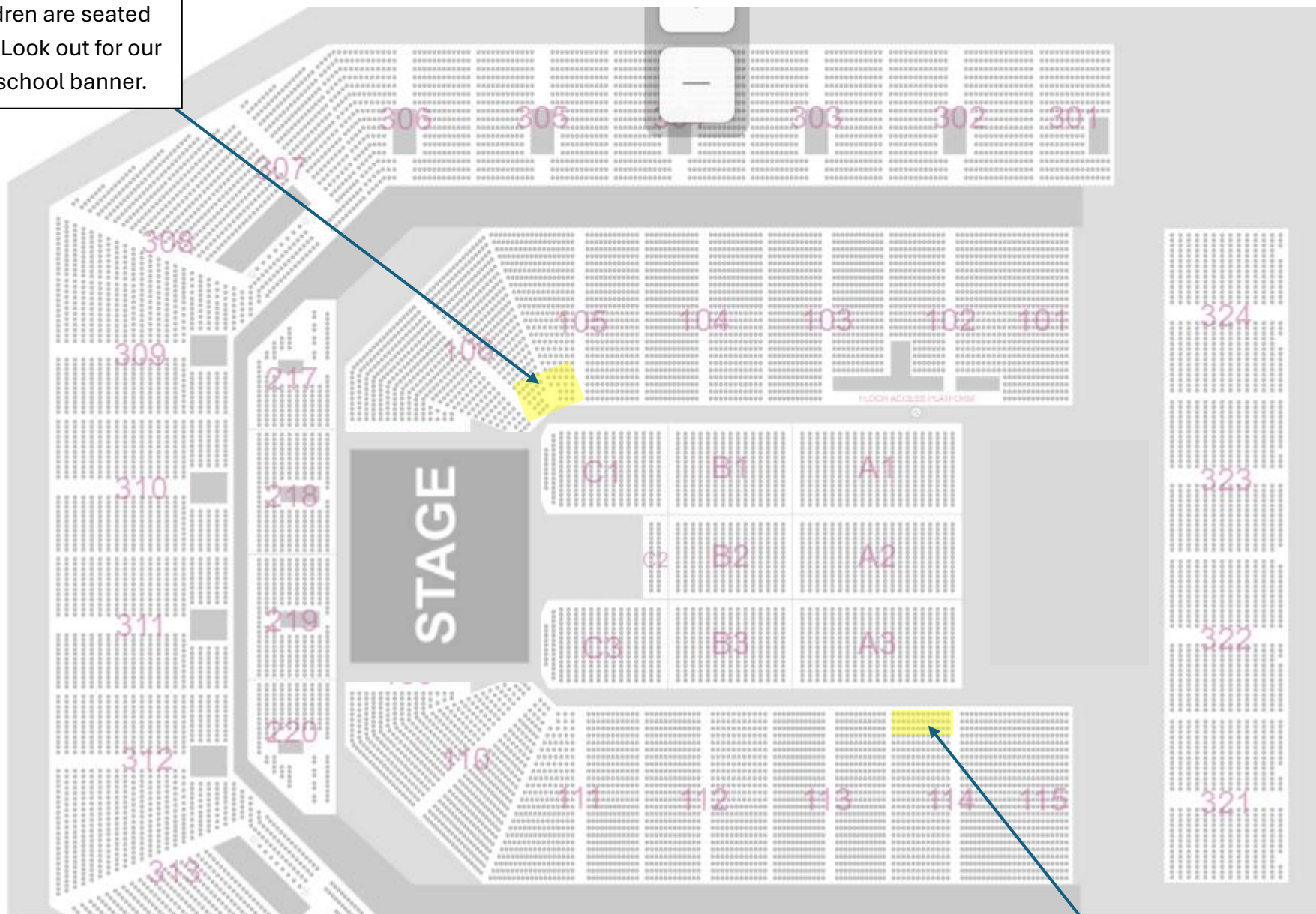
Checklist for audience members	✓
Tickets for the event (electronic). <i>Each attending audience member must have their own ticket.</i> These have already been transferred to ticket holders. If you do not have your tickets, please get in touch with school ASAP.	
Ensure you have made travel and car parking arrangements. Those travelling on the school-organised minibus- The bus will depart from outside school at 3:40pm. Your seats are booked under your child's name.	
Doors open at 6pm. <i>Allow time for enhanced security checks.</i> Concert begins at 7pm.	
Binoculars- <i>Seriously!</i> It will help you to spot your child.	
Parents are welcome to make your way to the bottom of our block when you arrive to say hello <i>(if you are able to)</i> . We'll be looking out for you! Check the seating allocation sheet attached to know where to look for us and keep an eye out for our red school banner.	
Take something to help us spot you! If you able to take something to help us identify you in the crowd it really helps your child to find you- which is what they are all desperate to do once the audience start arriving.	
Concert ends at approximately 8:45pm. Please <u>do not</u> try to find your child on the way out of the arena. Leaving the concert is very busy and we want to ensure that we get all of our children back on the bus safely- any distractions can hinder this process. We really appreciate your support with this.
