RE: Young Voices 2026!

Dear Parent/Carer,

It is that time of year again when we invite our Key Stage 2 children to take part in Young Voices! If your child will be in Key Stage 2 from September (Year 3, 4, 5, or 6) *currently year 2-5*, they have the opportunity to join us in one of our favourite events of the year.

What is Young Voices?

For those of you that have not been before, Young Voices is the UK's largest choir, where the children get to perform alongside thousands of others and incredible artists in front of a full arena audience of family and friends. To achieve this with all their school friends around them for support helps their self-belief, self-motivation, confidence, and ability to communicate as part of a team - which is invaluable! Add to this the numerous health benefits of singing in rehearsals, including breathing exercises to focus the mind - it's no wonder that Young Voices is over-subscribed year after year!

The Details...

The children will need to commit to weekly lunchtime rehearsals which will begin in September and be willing to practise the songs/ dance moves at home too. Due to limited dates and high demand at Sheffield (our usual venue), we have instead been allocated our place at the Coop Live Arena, Manchester (*not Birmingham as we originally thought when the survey was published*). Our school will perform at **Coop Live, Manchester on Thursday 12th February 2026**. On the day of the concert, children will need to be available from the start of the school day until we return from the concert approximately 11:30pm.

What does it cost?

We do not charge the children to attend Young Voices; registration and transport is fully funded by school. However, there are some optional costs to the event. It is recommended that children purchase a Young Voices T-Shirt pack (containing the official Young Voices t-shirt to be worn at the concert and small YV torch light to be used on the night). These cost £15 each. If you choose not to purchase one of the t-shirts, children can wear a plain white t-shirt for the concert instead (children are not permitted to wear t-shirts from previous years). Also, one of the best parts of the concert is having a huge group of friends and family in the audience supporting us. Audience tickets are £24 each. For this you are getting a full 2-hour arena concert with celebrity guest artists, dance acts and of course your children singing- you may even get up on your feet too! All audience tickets need to be purchased through school. I know that others who have attended before will tell you that this is a really great night for everyone! We are aware that with the change of arena, this will impact our travelling audience and we are currently looking into the cost of providing a bus for our audience members. Further information regarding this will be sent out as soon as possible.

What next?

Although it seems a while away, we need to submit our confirmed choir numbers by the end of this school term. There is no limit to the amount of spaces available but we do have a strict cut off deadline to sign up by. **If your child would like to attend Young Voices next year, please EMAIL Miss Worboys at rworboys@cuckney.notts.sch.uk by Friday 25th July to be added to the list.** All requests for places by this date will be granted. Once your place has been confirmed via reply email, you will receive a further letter with more details and information regarding ordering tickets and t-shirts (orders will need to be placed by the end of September, however the final balance will not need to be paid until the week before the event in February).
