RE: Front boundary fence work

Dear Parents / Carers,

As you are aware the planned work to the front boundary didn't take place over the summer holiday. The delay was caused by the finials on top of the iron gates taking longer to manufacture than expected. When they finally did arrive, a further delay was caused as they were not attached to the fence correctly.

The good news is they are now complete and ready to install. However, the school has been given little advance notification of this. The ground work will begin on Wednesday 25th September, with expected completion of this part on or before Friday 27th September. The fitting of the fence will then take place on Wednesday 2nd October, again expected completion on or before Friday 4th October.

We have arranged with the contractors that they will only work on site after 9.00am and finish each day at 3.00pm. This will allow access for parents to pick up and drop off in the usual way, with the exception of Holbeck class, who will now line up in the main playground and be collected by teachers from there. They will also be dismissed from this big playground.

We ask that all visits to site are kept to a minimum during this time. However, if you do need to drop off or collect between 9 and 3 then access to the school building will be via the top red door.

We also ask parents not to drive up School Lane, nor park on the junction of School Lane and Bakers Row to allow access to the contractor vehicles. We have been asked to ensure that the front boundary wall is free from parked cars to allow access for contractors to work.

Thank you in advance for your support and understanding as we manage the delayed installation. We look forward to seeing the project finished.
