"SATs, the McDonald's after SAT's and the play!" Aimee-Leigh, Year 6

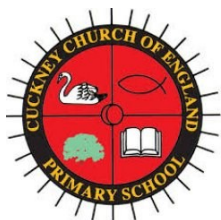
"Fun and laughter" Mrs McNally, Welbeck Teacher
