Science

- Know how materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching.
- Know why a material might or might not be used for a specific job.

English



We are learning to:

- Continue to apply phonic knowledge and skills as the route to decode words.
- Write for different purposes.
- Participate in discussions about what is read to them, taking turns and listening to what others say.
- Sequence sentences to form short narratives.
- Discuss and clarify the meanings of words, linking new meanings to known vocabulary.
- Making inferences on the basis of what is being said and done.
