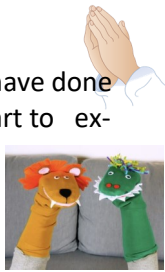


# Sherwood Class homework Autumn Term 2021

- Research habitats and what animals need to survive.

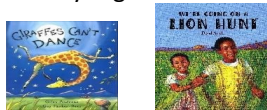

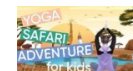
