Daily routine	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Children will be collected from the field by their teacher at 8:30am each morning. Children will need collecting from the field at 3:00pm home time. Children can still order snack each morning for break time. The snack menu remains unchanged and can be accessed on our school website. Please try to bring the correct change where possible. It is advised that children come to school and go home in their wellies and leave their school shoes at school to change into each day. Don't forget to bring your school shoes with you on Monday! Remember to bring a water bottle back to school, your lunchbox (if sandwiches) and your PE kit (see below for day change).
Timetable	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The class timetable remains largely unchanged. A copy of this can be found on the page 2. CHANGE: PE will now be on a Wednesday afternoon (children are welcome to leave their PE kits in school all week). This will be outdoors, so please send appropriate kit and footwear.
Please remember to bring back to school on Monday :	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Whiteboard packs containing: whiteboard, whiteboard pen, whiteboard rubber and any laminated support mats (i.e. sound maths, hundred squares etc.) All school work books: blue English book, yellow maths book, green topic book, beige handwriting book. <i>(Purple homework books are to remain at home as before).</i> All completed additional sheets or work that is not stuck in books. <i>Children do not need to bring back any unused or uncompleted sheets/ booklets i.e. the remaining big maths, TTRS or guided reading texts.</i>
Google Classroom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Our online Google Classroom platform will remain 'live' and accessible throughout the year. We will be using Google Classroom to set homework moving forwards. <i>(Please note that there will be no homework for the remainder of this half term as the children settle back into the routine of school- all children should continue to read regularly and practice spellings, big maths and TTRS at home).</i>
