Word classes: Nouns, verbs and adjectives.

Noun: A person, place or object.
Usually something you can touch.

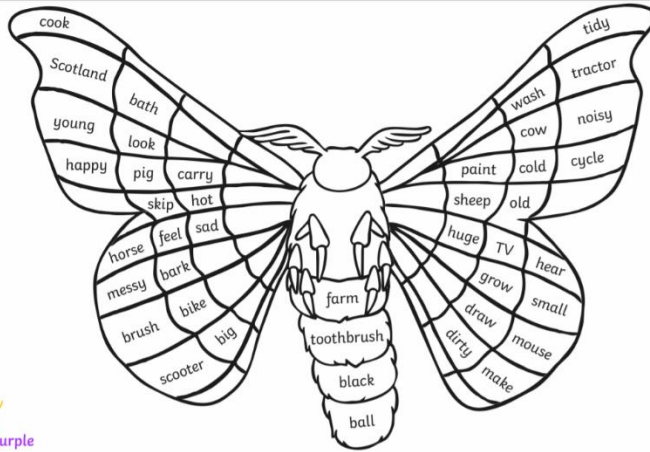
Verb: A doing word.
An action.

Adjective: A describing word.

Colour by Word Class

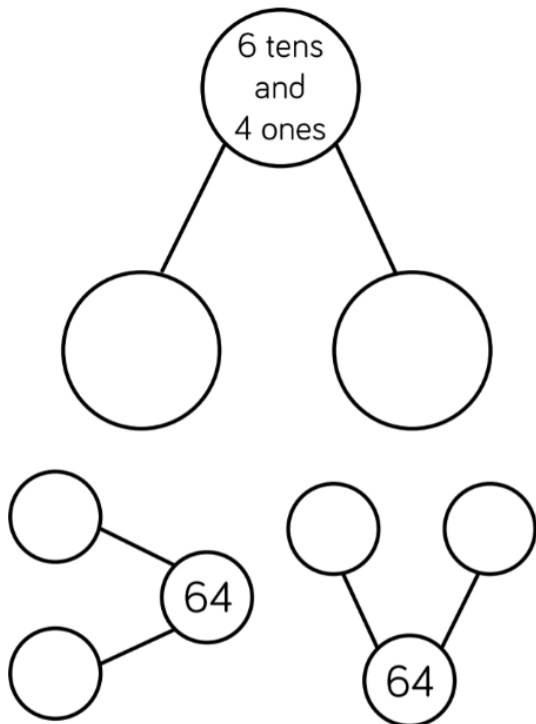
I can recognise nouns, verbs and adjectives.
Can you identify which are these words are nouns, verbs or adjectives using a colour code?

Verbs = Yellow
Nouns = Blue
Adjectives = Purple



Task: Either print the sheet (downloadable from website) and colour by word class OR copy down the words from the sheet into a grid in your homework book, sorting them into nouns, verbs or adjectives.

3. Maths Task



Part-whole model: This week we have been using the part-whole model to partition numbers in different ways. A part-whole model works by splitting the 'whole' (64 in the question) into 'parts' (e.g. 60 and 4 or 50 and 14).

Task: Complete the 3 part-whole models in different ways. You may want to draw tens and ones to help you.

Challenge: Can you think of anymore ways to partition 64?
