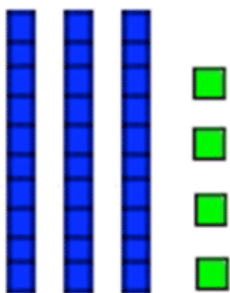

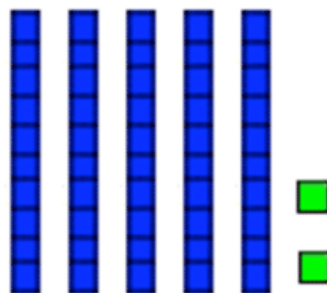

**Tens and ones:** What numbers are represented below? Write your answers in both numerals AND words.

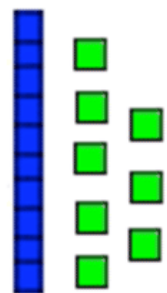

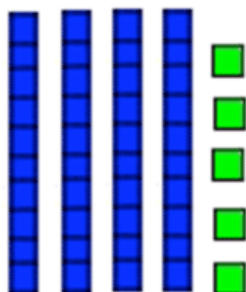
