**RE: Sherwood Class General Reminders**

Dear Parent/Carer,

We wanted to share a few gentle reminders based on some recent observations in class, to help ensure that our school days run smoothly and safely for everyone.

**Toys in School**

We have noticed an increase in children bringing toys, teddies, fidgets, and other small objects from home. As a reminder, toys are not permitted in school unless specifically requested by a member of staff for a particular activity. These items can become distractions in class and we want to keep everyone focused and ready to learn.

**PE Kit Expectations**

A number of children have been arriving with incorrect PE kit. PE kit is part of our school uniform policy and should include:

- **Indoor PE:** black or navy shorts and a white t-shirt. Indoor black plimsolls are optional.
- **Outdoor PE/Games:** the same shorts and t-shirt, with suitable footwear. In colder weather, children may wear a navy or black tracksuit.
- **Please avoid large or obvious sports logos.**

Children must bring the appropriate kit and footwear **every Wednesday**. Long hair must be tied up and all jewellery removed (including earrings) for health and safety reasons. As a reminder, children will be outdoors for PE (weather permitting) for the remainder of the school year.

**Reading Diaries and Water Bottles**

Please ensure that children bring their **reading diaries and reading books every day**, as these are an important part of their learning routine. All children should also bring a **water bottle daily** so they can stay hydrated throughout the day.
