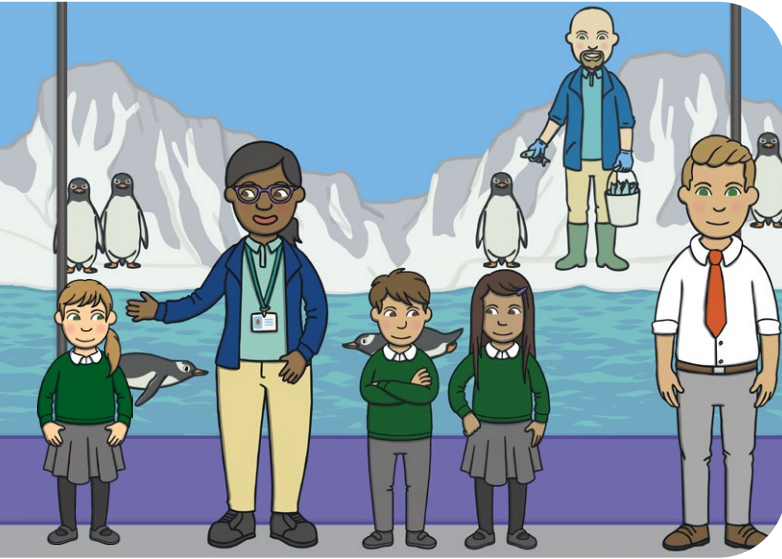




The Sea Park

Adult Guidance

Please find below the reading comprehension questions and some handy talking points for your class after the children have read the minibook. These are designed to be adult-led and encourage discussion either one-to-one, in a small group or with the whole class.

1. What is a pup?

Answer: A baby seal.

Follow-up questions:

- Are there any other animals whose babies are pups? Or puppies?
- Do you know any other names of baby animals?
- How do you think the adult seals look after their pups?

2. What do you think a 'leader' is?

Answers might include: Someone who greets you. Someone to show you around. Someone who tells you about the animals. Someone who shows you the way. You follow the leader.

Discussion points:

- What do you think a good leader should be like?
- Can you think of a time when you have been a leader?

3. Can you think of three animals that are shorter than a shark?

Children to share their ideas.

Discussion points:

- Are there any animals that are bigger than a shark?
- What do you think is the biggest sea creature?
- How about the biggest land creature?
