

Paper Boat Word Sort



Level 5

Kit, Sam and Grime have found King Bones' boat. Why not make paper boats with **o_e** words on!



You will need:

- A piece of paper. It could be yellow like King Bones'!
- Blue paper or material for display.
- Two smaller pieces of blue paper or fabric for word sort. One with a tick on, one with a cross on.

What to do:

1. Fold the paper in half.
2. Fold it in half again.
3. Fold the corners to the middle.
4. Fold the bottom rectangle upwards.
5. Turn it over and fold the bottom rectangle up on the other side.
6. Take the middle of the triangle shape and pull both sides whilst holding the red spot. Your paper should now look like this picture!
7. Fold the front layer up (as shown with the green spot).
8. Turn the boat over and the same with the back layer to make a triangle.
9. Pull the sides out to make a square shape.
10. Slowly pull out the top parts to complete the boat.

For the word sort:

11. Write a real or nonsense **o_e** word on your boat.
12. When everyone in the class has completed their boat and written their real or nonsense o_e word on it, place the paper boats on the paper or fabric for display.
13. Invite members of the class to come over, pick a boat that isn't theirs and read the **o_e** word on it.
14. Children to place the boat on the designated tick or crosspiece of paper according to whether it is real or fake.
