

Fork fireworks

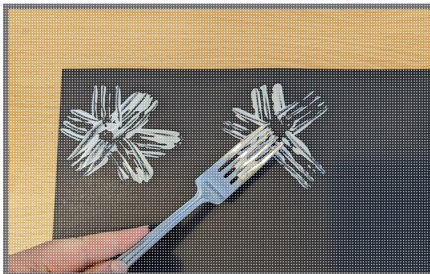


You will need:

- Black card
- Paint, in a variety of colours
- Fork
- Skyline template
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- Grey card
- Plastic plate
- White or yellow chalk



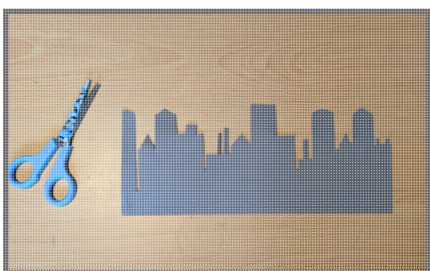
1) First, squirt a dollop of each paint colour onto a plastic plate, so that the colours are not touching.



2) Dip the flat base of your fork into one colour of paint and scrape the fork across the black card. Make a star shape.



3) Repeat Step 2 with different paint colours. You could layer two or three layers of paint to make one colourful firework. Allow the paint to dry.



4) Print out the Skyline template onto the grey card. Cut out the outline neatly.



5) Spread the glue onto the back of the card skyline. Place the skyline at the bottom of the firework painting. Allow the glue to dry.



6) Using the chalk, create small vertical lines inside the buildings. This will look like the lit up windows.
