

Langwith Class Plan Autumn Term



Literacy

Our Literacy work this term will be based on texts connected to our topic. We will also be studying Stories With Familiar Settings, Fantasy Stories, Information texts, Recounts, Poems about Creating Images and Syllabic Poems.

There is also a Big Writing Week.

PHSE

This term we will focus on the Jigsaw themes of 'Being in My World' and 'Celebrating Differences'. There will also be an anti-bullying week.

Design and Technology

As part of our topic work we will be making various artefacts connected to the Vikings including small model longboats and clay pots and runes.

We will be making and tasting some Viking foods.

RE

During our RE sessions we will study local places of worship and also think about what faith is by studying different people who have shown great faith in their lives.

As part of our topic work we will also look at Viking sagas, myths and legends and make a study of their gods and beliefs.

Science

In our Science sessions we will learn about our bodies and think about how the different parts work.

We will also explore how plants were used by the Vikings for things like natural dyes.

The Vikings

PE

During games sessions we will work on improving our fitness as well as basic ball skills by undertaking activities associated with striking and fielding activities.

We will also be undertaking gymnastics sessions.

Music

Your child will listen to music by Scandinavian groups and composers.

We will also learn about musical instruments used by the Vikings.

We will be undertaking weekly Ukulele sessions with an outside tutor.

Foundation Studies

In our topic sessions we will find out key facts about where the Vikings came from and why they travelled to other countries.

We will then focus on their lifestyle and culture and find out about how the arrival of the Vikings affected our country.

ICT

We will use the internet to research information for our Vikings topic and use word processing skills to produce our own pieces of topic work.

Numeracy

Our Numeracy work this term will involve studying the following areas:- Place value, mental and written calculation strategies, shape, measuring length, time, data analysis and fractions. The children will also be undertaking weekly mental arithmetic tests.
