Dear Parents,

Welcome to Langwith Class. I hope you all had a lovely holiday. I look forward to working in partnership with you this year, together with Miss Tindall, Mrs Kay and Miss Kennerley.

I have written the details of the work I hope to cover with your child on a separate sheet, but our main class topics for this term will be:-

Main topic The Vikings

Science topic Animals including humans, which covers studying the body and healthy living.

Our PE sessions for this half term will be outdoor games, which will take place on a Tuesday and Gymnastics which will take place on a Monday. Please could you ensure that your child has their PE kit in school on these days. They can bring tracksuits for outdoor PE and have a pair of trainers.

Your child will have a French lesson each week and this will take place on a Wednesday morning and also a Ukulele lesson each week for this term, with a music teacher.

Your child will have homework each week which will be sent out on a Friday and needs to be returned by Wednesday morning. They will also have spellings to learn for a test on Fridays.

Please could you hear your child read as often as possible, because it really does make a difference to their progress.

Please could your child bring in to school an old, large shirt or an apron, to use for art and craft activities. This will be sent home for washing as required.
