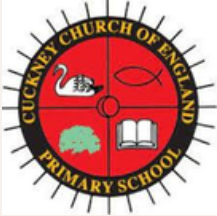

We would like to kindly remind parents that there will be **no after school club** on **Friday 27th March**, as is usual on the last day of term.

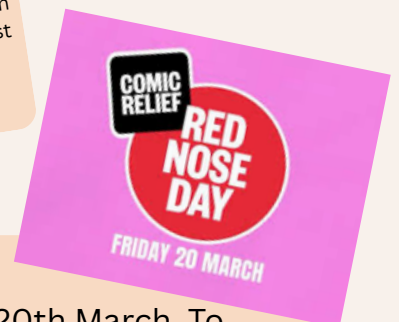
