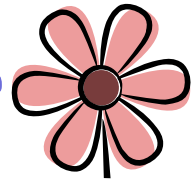

We strongly encourage all parents and carers of participating children to attend. We look forward to seeing you there.

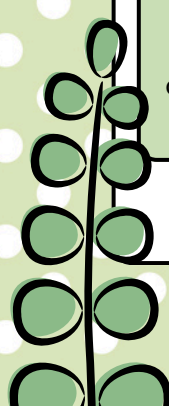
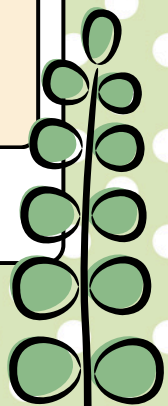
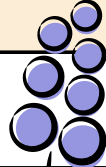
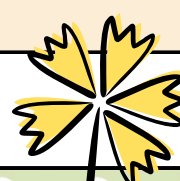
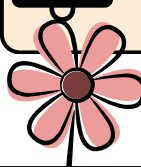
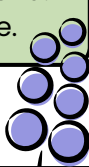
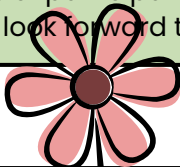

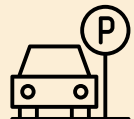


Parking Reminder
